Task 1:

Brainstorm together: What do you know about Napoléon Bonaparte? Make notes on the information you collect.

After that, check Napoléon's CV on Wikipedia.

Task 2:

Now, move on to think about an important person from your own country, for example a politician. Why is this person important? Explain it to your partner.

Task 3:

Imagine you are the important person you described in task 2 and meet Napoléon Bonaparte at a party.

Imagine the kind of conversation these two people could have (topics could be history, personal success stories/mishaps, politics in the past and the present, plans for the future, stories from their private life, etc).
