Point to a part of your body. Your partner will ask, whether it hurts. Answer him/her. Change roles several times.



### Task 2:

Compare doctors and hospitals in your countries.

When do you go to the doctor in ... France/Italy/..., when do you go to the hospital? Can you choose your own doctor? Do you have to pay for the doctor?



Do you need to have your own health insurance? What does health insurance cost? Are specialist doctors only available in hospitals or can you go to a specialist in town? As a foreigner, can you go to the doctor just with your EHIC card?

#### Follow-up activity:

- Making an appointment at the doctor's
- A visit to the doctor
- A phone call to the emergency line (after an accident, for a flatmate)
- A chat with a sick flatmate: comfort him/her, give him/her advice
