Task 2:

Question: How often do you play football?

How often do you watch a film?

Answers: I play football every day.

I rarely watch a film.

7 days/week → always/every day

6 days/week → very often

5 days/week → often

4 days/week → (quite) a lot

3 days/week → sometimes

2 days/week → rarely

1 day/week → very rarely

0 days/week → never
